Also included are a soft plastic phone case and leather pouch suitable for two of today's most popular handset models. The classic Capdase frosted-yet-transparent plastic case is wear resistant, dustproof and scratchproof, thanks to adoption of imported environment-friendly TPU 80-85 soft-touch plastic.

Printed on the case are an iPANDAS logo plus dim sum characters "Shrimp Dumplings" and "Xiao Long Bao" as an affectionate representation of Kelly's two children, who support this community-spirited cause.
