Management & Security

Always under management: No need to worry about devices being unmanaged because devices are enrolled immediately from initial setup with no opportunity to skip the process.

Security controls always in place: Policies and restrictions are enforced from first usage of the device.

Enable large Android device deployments: Companies can now easily deploy Android at scale.

Device theft deterrent: Zero-touch can help deter thefts since lost or stolen devices remain registered in the zero-touch platform and will be re-enrolled after any factory reset.

Simplified configuration process: IT admins can create device configurations in the cloud and have them pushed automatically to devices during setup.

No manual intervention: IT admins do not have to manually set up devices for use (no NFC bumps, no QR code scanning)

Expanded device choice for enrollment: IT admins are not limited to devices from one manufacturer as zero-touch enrollment is supported by multiple Android device manufacturers across a range of form factors and price points.

Quick and Easy Deployment



1. Enterprise customers purchase devices* from a carrier.
2. Carrier creates new customer zero-touch enrollment accounts.
3. Carrier assigns devices to customers.
4. Enterprise customers create EMM configurations for their enterprise.
5. Enterprise customers map purchased devices to EMM configurations.
6. Carriers ship the devices to end user locations.
7. End users turn on their new device.
