


Roaming Tips for iPhone users:

Let's stay connected with family and friends with 3Business reliable and smooth roaming network while you are on the go. Your iPhone will automatically select a network for you upon your arrival. Here are the steps to connect to a local mobile network manually if your iPhone cannot connect automatically:

1. Turn on/off data roaming.

Don't forget to turn on data roaming when traveling abroad to stay connected.




1. From your iPhone's home screen, tap **Settings**.



2. Tap **Mobile Data** (Cellular, or Cellular Data).



3. Tap Mobile Data Options.




4. Turn on **Data Roaming**.



2. Turn on/off Wi-Fi calling

Before departing from Hong Kong, please turn off Wi-Fi Calling on your iPhone to ensure that voice calls can be made smoothly when you are outside Hong Kong.




1. From your iPhone's home screen, tap **Settings**.



2. Tap Phone.



Tap Wi-Fi Calling.




4. Turn off **Wi-Fi Calling on This iPhone** to disable Wi-Fi calling.



3. Enable VoLTE (Voice Over LTE) (For iPhone 11 and previous models with iOS 15 and later only).

Please activate the VoLTE service to enjoy the high quality voice call over 4G network while roaming.



- Tap Mobile Data (Cellular, or Cellular Data).
- 2. Tap Mobile Data Options.
- 3. Tap Voice & Data.
- 4. Turn on VoLTE.

Remarks:

- 1. VoLTE is enabled by default for iPhone 12 or later with the latest iOS version.
- 2. Some roaming networks have already shut down their 2G and 3G networks and now only support VoLTE roaming services.



4. Turn on/off airplane mode


Enabling airplane mode on your iPhone before boarding a flight is recommended to comply with airline regulations and avoid any potential interference with the aircraft's communication systems. **Additionally, turning on airplane mode 30 seconds then turn off can also help resolve network issues on your iPhone**. To enable or disable airplane mode, please follow the below steps:



From your iPhone's home screen, 2. tap Settings.



. Turn on Airplane Mode.



3. Airplane mode has been turned on. Return to the Home screen.

Important: Please remember to turn off airplane mode upon landing to restore your iPhone's wireless connections.



Manual network selection

If your iPhone cannot connect to a local network automatically, please connect to a local mobile network manually. Please refer to the link in *Roaming Service provided to find the appropriate roaming network for your destination.




1. From your iPhone's home screen, tap **Settings**.




2. Tap **Mobile Data** (Cellular, or Cellular Data)



3. Choose Network Selection.



4. Turn off Automatic.



- 5. The Apple iPhone is now searching for available networks
- 6. Choose the Available network.
- 7. The Apple iPhone has been logged onto the selected network. Return to the Home screen.

Important:

Please remember to restore the network settings to automatic mode from your iPhone when you are back to Hong Kong or in other countries.




Q&A:

4. Network types will also be shown.



Should I restart my iPhone?

Mobile phones may experience connection issues with the mobile network occasionally and you can improve its performance just by restarting your iPhone. Restarting your iPhone can help resolving network and connectivity problems by forcing it to reconnect to the mobile network. Apps running in the background may cause battery drain, slow performance, overheating, and other conflicts. Restarting can help to clear the phone's memory, close any running apps, and resolve any conflicts.

How to restart iPhone?

- 1. Press and quickly release the volume up button.
- 2. Press and quickly release the volume down button.
- 3. Press and hold the side button.
- 4. When the Apple logo appears, release the side button.
